Mosquito abatement will begin mid-April! While we are doing our part to help control the mosquito population, there are things that you can do to protect yourself & your loved ones and to reduce mosquitoes around your home:

- *Use insect repellent
- *Wear protective clothing
- *Treat clothing and outdoor gear
- *Check for ticks
- *Unclog roof gutters
- *Empty children's wading pools at least once a week, or more often
- *Change water in birdbaths at least weekly
- *Empty outdoor flower pots regularly or store them upside down so that they can't collect water
- *Drain your fire pit if water collects there AND please remember to treat your animals to protect them from fleas & ticks!

Cemetery Decoration Guidelines

It is important to commemorate your loved ones, and decorating their graves is one way to do that. Our goal is to keep the cemetery grounds & plots in good condition for all patrons. Together, we can maintain a beautiful & well-kept environment for all visitors. Decorating should be done in a way that does not create a safety hazard, impede proper maintenance, or infringe on other graves. Please remove decorations when they become dead, faded, broken or anything of a similar nature. We also ask that you refrain from using shepherd hooks for hanging plants. The maintenance department may remove decorations which may create a safety hazard or cause maintenance burdens.
